As well as museums and other interesting tourist places such as the Retiro Park or the Rastro (a second-hand market), its traditional neighborhoods, such as the Austrias or the Plaza Mayor also deserve special attention.

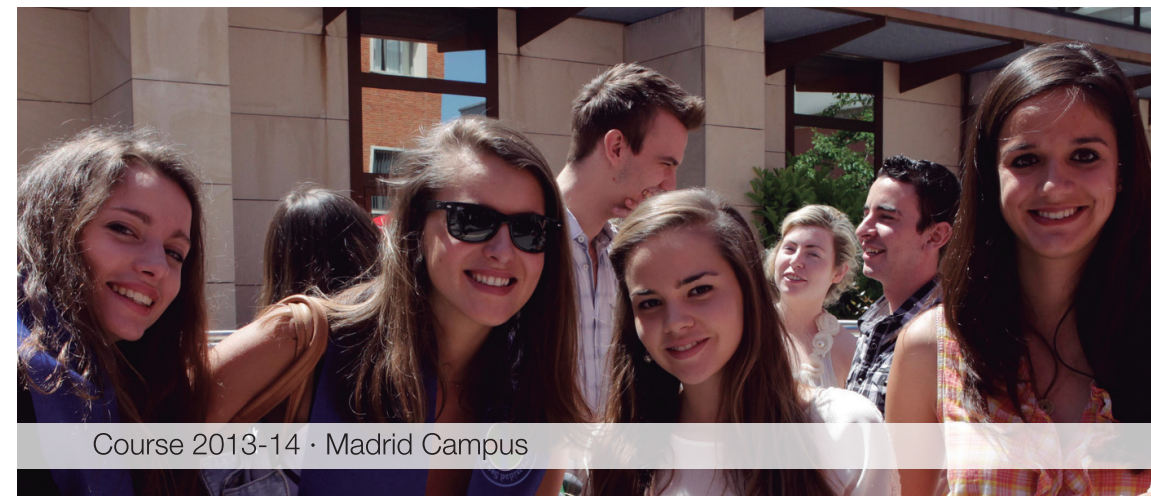
Accommodation

CEU San Pablo University offers students the possibility of living a Study Abroad experience in Madrid following a study program specially designed to learn Spanish through a cultural immersion experience. CEU San Pablo University is a private University with more than 80 years of educational experience. It is located in the center of Madrid with perfect connections by metro or bus to the main sites which may be of interest for students.

The course will take place from September to May, both months included, and has a total of 650 teaching hours. Classes will be divided in **two semesters**:

First semester: September to December.

Second semester: January to May.

At the end of the course, students should have reached a B1 or B2 level.

In order to complete the Spanish experience of the international students our University the course also includes Extra-Curricular Activities in the afternoon.

Subjects will be distributed into **four blocks**:

- # Language and Communication.
- # Oral and written skills.
- # Spanish Civilization (first quarter).
- # Spanish culture: art, history, film, literature (second semester).
